Rediscovering our relationship with God and creation in light of the Pope's Encyclical, Laudato Si' and the Universe Story – continues Thursday, March 23 with Sr. Denise Lirette, fj from 7 -8:30 PM at Holy Family Church Hall.

"Amazing Grace: Discovering God's Gifts in our Lives": The Lenten Mission continues Sunday, March 19<sup>th</sup> beginning at 6:30 PM at Holy Family Church. Join Claudette Derdaele, our second presenter as she speaks of "God's Generous Gift Offered Again and Again and Again and ...." Claudette is the Director of the Lay Formation Program with the diocese of Saint John. Among other initiatives, she has facilitated several retreats for the archdiocese of Moncton, and is active in many other areas of the diocese. Each presentation of the Mission is independent of the other so feel free to come, even if you were unable to join us last week, as we take a closer look at God's Amazing Grace. The final presentation for the Mission will take place March 26th.

**Liturgical Celebrations during Lent:** The second opportunity to become more familiar with the ritual prayer, **Sunday Celebration of the Word and Hours**, will take place <u>April 4<sup>th</sup>, 7 PM, St. Augustine's, 340 Dominion Street, Moncton.</u> **Sunday Celebration of the Word and Hours** is the **official** ritual to be used when no priest is available to preside at Sunday Mass. The English Diocesan Pastoral Council has requested that two opportunities to celebrate this official prayer of the Church be organized during the Season of Lent. Members of all the English parishes (and especially liturgical ministers) are encouraged to take advantage of the opportunity to gather together to pray this liturgy.

**Note**: Following each of the liturgies, all those present, including the liturgical ministers, are invited to remain to discuss and ask questions about this ritual.

**Pilgrimage to Spain & Portugal:** A pilgrimage to holy sites and some amazing secular sites in Spain and Portugal between Sep. 18 and Oct. 2, 2017 is planned. Spain will include city tours of Barcelona, Madrid, Salamanca, Avila, Santiago de Compostela, to name a few, as well as many places inhabited by St. Teresa of Avila, St. John of the Cross, and St. James, one of the original apostles of Jesus. Once in Portugal, we will spend time in Porto, Obidos, Lisbon and, of course, in Fatima to participate in the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Blessed Virgin Mary's appearance to the children Francisco, Jacinta, and Lucia in 1917.
