


Rite of Enrollment for Confirmation



Journey to the Holy Land - A pilgrimage to the Holy Land will take place Oct 15-24, 2018

This trip will include stops at our Lord's birthplace in Bethlehem and well as five days in the holy city of Jerusalem where Christ's passion and resurrection occurred. While in Jerusalem, we will visit the Mount of Olives, the walled city of Old Jerusalem, the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, and the Holocaust Museum, to mention a few. Outside of Jerusalem, the journey continues in Galilee where Jesus performed most of his miracles and did most of his preaching concerning the Kingdom of God. While there we will visit the Mount of the Beatitudes, Caesarea, Haifa, and Megiddo, as well as Capernaum and the place where the multiplication of the fish and loaves took place. The last part of the journey takes us for a "float" in the Dead Sea and an exploration of Qumran and Masada. Transformed Through Eucharist: What happens during the Eucharist? How important is Eucharist to you? Why are you preparing your child to make their First Communion?




