
Development and Peace – Caritas Canada is bringing people Together for Peace

Saint Bernard's Church - Building Committee Update

Background:

During a meeting with Parishioners in June 2016, your Building Committee made the recommendation to:

- 1. **Decommission the Rectory** (with the intention of demolishing the structure)
- 2. Create additional parking (for the parishioners)

The recommendation was made as the building committee considered parking to be the most pressing need for the parishioners.

We were asked at that presentation to consider other options that would help to keep the rectory intact.

The Committee still felt that the most pressing need for our Parishioners were:

- 1. parking for the parishioners, and
- 2. ensuring that we work out a resolution for the rectory that is in the best interest of the parish.

The parking issue became even more evident with the loss of available parking due to the recent development of the structure across the street. The Owner of the property adjacent to our Church also communicated his intentions of a future development that would further restrict available parking for Parishioners.

Saint Bernard's Church - Building Committee Update

Updated Recommendation:

In the course of examining other options, we opened communications with the owner who owns the parking lot beside the Church and is used by our Parishioners for weekend Masses.

He maintained his position of developing the land, but through a series of negotiations, finally agreed to purchase and develop the Rectory in accordance with City Heritage recommendations.

He would do this, provided that we purchase this land adjacent to the Church. We, as a Committee, felt that this provided a solution to both the approaching parking issue and the future of the Rectory.

Moving Forward: At our Parishioner meetings of February 10 -11, 2018, we reviewed the details of the proposal as well as the deadline for the purchase and sale transaction which is *June 30, 2018*.

Your Pastoral Ministry Team and Building Committee strongly recommend the acceptance of the proposal. The Bishop and the Finance Director of the Diocese, who have also participated in some of our meetings, are very supportive with this purchase and sale transaction.

In order to meet the necessary payment arrangements at the time of purchase, your building Committee will be initiating a **Capital Fund Raising Campaign**, the details of which will be presented in future meetings, mail-outs, telephone and bulletin updates.

We are asking for the Parishioners to support and be a part of this significant milestone for our Church.

We will also be looking for **volunteers** to help us with the many activities needed to make it happen.
