

## Campaign 2018

**Our Vision:** As a **vibrant faith community**, we will continue to create an **environment** that promotes a **sense of belonging** for **all generations** while reinforcing Saint Bernard's **history** and **architectural presence** 

**Background:** Our original campaign launched in May, 2009, focused on the enhancement of the physical structure of St. Bernard's including the installation of an elevator and major renovations to the downstairs to allow for the continued growth of the parish community through accessibility and functional space for classes, workshops, social events and a welcoming physical environment.

The launch of the 2018 campaign is aimed at preserving the iconic presence of St. Bernard's architectural structure and beauty in downtown Moncton, funding extensive repairs to our roof and to the inside of the Church, and most importantly securing additional parking for the many Parishioners attending weekend Masses and participating in Church activities throughout the week.

**The Proposal:** For some time, the Building Committee and the Pastoral Ministry Team had been exploring options on the future status of the vacant Rectory.

With the onset of new building developments close to our downtown location, we were also looking at opportunities to maintain our existing parking arrangements for Masses and other Church functions.

We had several discussions with a developer regarding the Rectory. This developer also was the Owner of the adjacent property that is used by Parishioners for weekend Masses.

As discussions progressed, we came to a mutual agreement to sell the Rectory to him for future development purposes, while at the same time purchasing his property adjacent to the Church to secure parking for our Parishioners.
