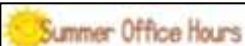

Negotiations continue with the rectory sale and parking lot purchase on the north side of the church. As expected, we are at a point where surveys, zoning applications, and ongoing assessments are being done before everything is signed off. To complete the deal may take us into the

early fall. The current owner of the parking lot leases the space to some downtown employees and as the transition occurs, there may be a period of time when a barricade or chain is in place at the entrance. This will be temporary and is part of the process while the sale is finalized, so we will continue with patience, prayer and planning in our work with this project.



Low Gluten Hosts

Gluten intolerance has become more prevalent in recent years. Prompted by faithful Catholics wanting to receive Communion, we have ordered a supply of low gluten hosts (yields less than .01% gluten content per bread/wafer). We already have a few parishioners that have sourced their own supply & place them in

their own personal pyx for consecration at mass. If you are diagnosed with gluten intolerance, you must purchase your personal pyx and low gluten hosts **are available** at our Parish office during office hours.
