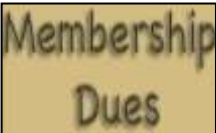

Book of the Faithful Departed

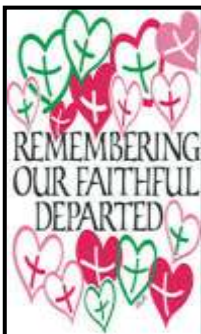


During the month of November,
