





### Next Sunday, April 14th is Palm Sunday

We celebrate the triumphal entry of Jesus Christ into Jerusalem, the week before his death and resurrection. Palm Sunday is also referred to as "Passion Sunday." It marks the beginning of

Holy Week, which concludes on Easter Sunday. When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the crowds greeted him by waving palm branches and covering his path with palm branches. Immediately following this great time of celebration in the ministry of Jesus, he begins his journey to the cross



Holy Week is the week which precedes the great Feast of the Resurrection on Easter Sunday - it includes the last days of Lent and the beginning of the Easter Triduum. During Holy Week, the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his life of earth, beginning with his messianic entrance.


## Knights of Columbus Council 1310. Men: Are You Ready to Accept the Challenge?

Gluten intolerance has become more prevalent in recent years. Prompted by faithful Catholics wanting to receive Communion, we have ordered a supply of low gluten hosts (yields less than .01% gluten content per bread/wafer). We already have a few parishioners that have sourced their own supply & place them in their

own personal pyx for consecration at mass. If you are diagnosed with gluten intolerance, you must purchase your personal pyx and low gluten hosts **are now available** at our Parish office during office hours.


### **Home Energy Assistance Program:**

Are you eligible for the provincial government's \$100 benefit under the Home Energy Assistance Program?

A one-time payment of \$100 to help NB families cope with high energy costs. To be eligible for the benefit under the Home Energy Assistance Program, families

### Parishioners in hospital:

Parishioners in Moncton City Hospital and the Georges Dumont Hospital are reminded that <u>if they wish to receive a visit from the parish priest</u>, <u>it is necessary to specifically identify themselves as being members of St. Bernard's parish when they are admitted to hospital</u>. The clergy visiting lists for priests and pastoral care visitors are printed out according

to parish identification. This means that <u>if you haven't identified yourself as belonging to our parish, the priest or pastoral care visitors will not be aware that you have been admitted to hospital and thus will not be able to visit. Due to changes in the "Privacy Act", PARISHIONERS IN HOSPITAL are reminded that if they wish a visit from a Priest, or to receive Holy Communion while in hospital, it is necessary to specifically identify themselves as being members of St. Bernard's parish and to state that "they wish to request a visit from a priest or from a member of the Parish Pastoral Care team." If they wish to receive a visit from the parish pastoral team, parishioners at the Georges Dumont Hospital are asked to contact the St. Bernard's parish office.</u>



Subject: Lenten Campaign for Development and Peace-Caritas Canada 5th Sunday of Lent: Solidarity Sunday

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

As has been the case each year for several decades, Development and Peace-Caritas Canada's Share Lent campaign is part of our diocesan preparation for Easter. This year, we are invited to join with Pope Francis in launching the annual Share the Journey campaign. Following a focus on forced migration in the fall, the Share the Journey campaign's Lenten theme calls us to promote the culture of encounter.

Taking a compassionate interest in the experiences of migrant people is a great step forward on this path of encounter which, in this time of Lent and conversion, leads us to a transformation of the heart. A culture of encounter prepares us to welcome new brothers and sisters into our communities, to share their migratory journey, to create life-long bonds, and to write together a story of solidarity, at the heart of which we meet Jesus Christ. A foreign Jesus among foreigners, migrants among migrants, and refugees among refugees.

On April 7<sup>th</sup>, the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent, we will celebrate Solidarity Sunday in every diocese across the country. This day represents an opportunity to reflect in Church on the human reality of forced migration. Today, 68.5 million women, men and children around the world have fled their homes. We will be invited to bring these forced migrants into our prayers, but also to give generously in support of the development programs and humanitarian aid already committed in several countries, and to act on the root causes of forced migration.

Additionally, in solidarity with those who have been forced to flee their homes, Share the Journey walks are being organized across Canada, with a goal of reaching a total of 40 075 km walked; the circumference of the Earth. Donations will be collected in the lead-up to these walks to support organizations working with migrant and refugee people in the Global South. In our diocese, a solidarity walk will be held on Holy Friday (April 19<sup>th</sup>) in Moncton, starting from Saint Bernard Church (43 Botsford Street) from 10 am to 12 pm.

During this Lenten season, let us be companions of our sister and brother migrants. Let us join them for a better world. Together, we can be a force that transforms fear and hate speech into messages of love, compassion and welcome. "I was a stranger, and you welcomed me." Mt 25:35.
