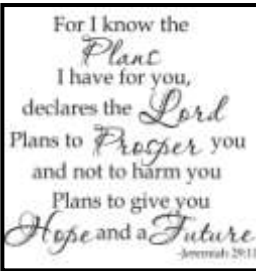

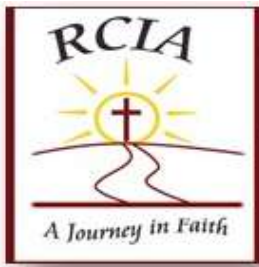

ARCHDIOCESE OF MONCTON 2019 APPOINTMENTS

For the priests, each year, comes a time of appointments and changes to ensure the best service possible to all Christian communities. Here are the appointments promulgated by Most Reverend Valéry Vienneau for the Archdiocese of Moncton. These appointments will be effective July 1st, 2019.

Father Jean-Guy Dallaire is appointed pastor (priest moderator) in the Saint Jean XXIII, Notre-Dame-des-Champs and Sainte-Famille pastoral units including the parishes of Saint-Jean-Baptiste (Boucouché), Sainte-Anne (Sainte-Anne), Notre-Dame-du-Mont-Carmel (Sainte-Marie), Saint-Paul (Saint-Paul), Saint-Pierre (Cocagne), Saint-Antoine-l'Ermite (St-Antoine) and Notre-Dame-du-Sacré-Cœur (Notre-Dame).

Father Guy Legendre is appointed pastor (priest moderator) in the Saint Jean-Paul II pastoral unit including the parishes of Notre-Dame de l'Assomption, Christ-Roi and Notre-Dame de Grâce and also the parish of Notre-Dame-de-la-Paix.

Father Jean-Bernard Mallais is appointed full-time assistant priest in the Saint Jean-Paul II pastoral unit including the parishes of Notre-Dame de l'Assomption, Christ-Roi and Notre-Dame de Grâce and also the parish of Notre-Dame-de-la-Paix.

Father Alphonse Richard is appointed Sunday vicar and a helper in ministry in the Providence pastoral unit, including the parishes of Saint-Joseph (Shédiac), St-Jacques-le-Majeur (Scoudouc) and La Visitation (Grande-Digue).

Father Angus Johnston is appointed pastor (priest-moderator) in the Queen of All Saints pastoral unit including the parishes of Saint Augustine (Moncton), St. Lawrence O'Toole (Irishtown) and Our Lady of Mercy (Pointe-du-Chêne).

Father Pyritho Marcellin, c.s.c., is appointed pastor (priest moderator) in the Sainte-Trinité pastoral unit including the parishes of St-Louis-de-Gonzague (Richibucto), St-Antoine-de-Padoue (Richibouctou-Village) and St-Charles (St-Charles Borromé).

Father Charles Lokoka is appointed part-time pastor (priest moderator) of the parish of Notre-Dame de l'Acadie at the University of Moncton and part-time chaplain at the Dr. Georges-L-Dumont Hospital and on call for the Moncton Hospital.

Father Alban Thibodeau is retiring from full-time ministry after 49 years of service for the Archdiocese of Moncton. I sincerely thank Fr. Thibodeau for his ministry. We wish him a well-deserved retirement as he will continue to offer his services as a substitute priest.

Father Aduel Joachim will be leaving us to return to his Ministry in France. We sincerely thank him for his three years of service with us. We wish him a successful and fruitful ministry.

Father Laurence Quin-Morris is retiring from the active Ministry because of health problems. We sincerely thank him for his 7 years of service in our archdiocese. We extend to him our best wishes for health in the future as he will continue to offer his services as a substitute priest.
