
Transformed Through Eucharist: What happens during the Eucharist? How important is Eucharist to you? Why are you preparing your child to make their First Communion? As parents of children preparing to receive First Eucharist in the spring of 2020 at any parish within the English sector, you are asked to attend this session taking place on Thursday, November 14th from 6:00 -8:30 pm at Holy Family Church Hall, Falkland Street, Moncton. At the session you will register your child to receive the sacrament, following which facilitators Karen LeBlanc and Ellen Bennett will offer an overview of the Liturgy of the Eucharist, and talk about how, through the Eucharist, the bread and wine and the assembly are transformed again into the Body of Christ. The Death of a Christian: Understanding Funeral Rituals from a Roman Catholic Perspective: Join Dr. Andrew Wilson and Deb Gillispie on Saturday, November 16th from 9:00 – 12:00 noon at St. Bernard's Church Hall as they speak about the importance of funerals. Issues such as: the evolution of the sacred and secular story of death and dying; understanding the ritual of the liturgy and why Roman Catholics do what we do during it; cremation and where we stand on this subject; the value of the funeral vigil and why it's pertinent to the funeral ritual, will be some of the points discussed. 
