



Thus, he loses all his rights and is suspended from his duties as a priest recognized by the Catholic Church. Yvon Arsenault had been removed from all ministries within the Archdiocese of Moncton and elsewhere since 2012 following allegations of sexual abuse of minors. On behalf of the Diocesan Church and as Archbishop of Moncton, I sincerely apologize to the victims and their families. We continue to be vigilant to ensure that anyone working in the Church fully complies with the policies in place to prevent abuse of any kind.



them in their own personal pyx for consecration at mass. If you are diagnosed with gluten intolerance, you must purchase your personal pyx and low gluten hosts **are now available** at our Parish office during office hours.

## The Christmas Season ends and Ordinary time begins the day after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

During Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God offer praise by celebrating the Paschal Mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus. On the first day of the week, the Lord's Day, God assembles the beloved people to hear the word, to reflect upon it, to offer the living sacrifice of praise and to eat and drink the banquet of the Lord. Then God sends them forth to proclaim this love by their words and actions. Sunday is the original Christian Feast Day, following the tradition handed down from apostolic times, for this was the day of the Lord's resurrection. Today's Christian communities continue this tradition by celebrating every Sunday as the day of the Risen Lord.
