

WORLD DAY FOR CONSECRATED LIFE - FEBRUARY 2ND

The purpose of the day is "to help the entire Church to esteem ever more greatly the witness of those persons who have chosen to follow Christ by means of the practice of the evangelical counsels" as well as "to be a suitable occasion for consecrated persons to renew their commitment and rekindle the fervor which should inspire their offering of themselves to the Lord" (Saint John Paul II, 1997)



World Day of the Sick - February 11th: The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. February 11 (Memorial of our Lady of Lourdes) highlights the healing ministry of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurses, health care institutions and pastoral care givers to restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease.



COMMUNAL CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

It is important that those who are sick and those around them understand the significance of the <u>Anointing of the Sick as a **sacrament**</u> <u>of healing</u>. Who should celebrate this sacrament? Those who are elderly and whose frailty is becoming more pronounced. Those adults and children who are suffering from a major illness. Illness comes in

many different forms; physical, mental, psychological, emotional, and spiritual. Those who are facing or recovering from surgery or serious medical tests. Those suffering from a serious accident. Those who suffer from chronic illness such as arthritis or diabetes. Those who care for the sick, especially those who are closely bound in love to them.

Mass and the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be held at St. Augustine's Church on Tuesday, February 11th at 12:00 noon. Everyone is invited and encouraged to participate in this celebration.



Christmas Boxes

On Dec. 20, St. Bernard's distributed 54 food boxes to those in need. These boxes contained food items that would feed a family for almost a week. Once again this year we collaborated with the Food Depot Alimentaire to register those receiving boxes and purchase the food items. Thank you to parishioners for financial contributions to this initiative and to St. Bernard's CWL, Knights of Columbus Council 1310 and the Ladies Auxiliary of 1310 for their donations. Leading up to delivery day many volunteers helped with the boxes in various ways. Confirmation candidates sorted the hats and mitts received according to sizes, and ladies from the church wrapped them for the boxes. The day prior to distribution of boxes a team of volunteers met to pick up, bring food to the church hall and prepare and

pack the boxes. The next day the perishable items were packed and the boxes were delivered by volunteers of all ages. The abundance of beautiful knitted items not only provided something for all of the boxes, we had many left over to take to ReConnect for the homeless, to local schools and some little baby items for the Pregnancy Wellness Center.
