



Share Lent 2020 - Lent prepares us for the heart of the Christian faith — the great Easter celebration of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ, our Lord. It is a time to have a heart-to-heart with God; to let oneself be more inhabited by Jesus, the Savior; to ask for peace for oneself, one's family and the peoples of the Earth; and to seek inner transformation through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. To give alms is to practice charity by making oneself close to those of the world who are in need. It means sharing, in the name of social justice, our comfort and abundance. It means being in solidarity with our sisters and brothers in the countries of the South who are striving to build a world of justice and peace, a world where all can live with dignity. In keeping with this seasonal spirit of Lent, Development and Peace - Caritas Canda calls us to reaffirm our commitment For our Common Home.
