March 16, 2020: Update re catechism and Coronavirus — Covid-19 On Friday, March 13, the all-party cabinet committee of the NB government made the decision to close all public schools in the province effective March 16 for two weeks. Also on March 13, the four bishops of New Brunswick, unanimously and in solidarity with the competent authorities of the province, decided that all Saturday afternoon and evening, and all Sunday Masses and Celebration of the Word will be cancelled as of March 21 until further notice. Therefore, it has been decided that all catechism sessions, including those for sacrament preparation, will be suspended beginning March 16th to 30th. By March 30th, you will receive an update on how we will proceed. Please note that the Archdiocese of Moncton is monitoring this rapidly evolving situation closely through the NB Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health and the Public Health Agency of Canada. We remind you again, that it is important to follow recommendations of the Government of Canada.


