Registering to attend Mass - ***Please note change below***

St. Bernard's weekend Masses are Saturdays @ 4 PM and Sundays at 11 AM.

In a perfect scenario, we would be able to accommodate 75 persons for a Mass while still respecting the social distancing. However, that amount will vary depending on the configuration of those who register. (families & individuals) Bubbles & or families are seated together. We would not sit someone in an available seat unless they were in the same bubble & or family. As a result, we may not be able to use all of our available seating.

Those who are 70 years of age or older, or who have medical or at-risk conditions, should carefully assess the risk when making the decision to attend Mass.

The <u>dispensation</u> (*permission to be exempted from the laws or observances of the Church*) of the Sunday <u>precept</u> ("You shall attend Mass on Sundays...# 2042 - Catechism of the Catholic Church) is extended for those who cannot go to church, inviting them to read the Word of God and pray in their homes and participate in the celebrations of the Mass Via the media (TV, radio, the internet).

To attend a Mass...you must register - Update: A rolling list will not be kept

To reserve a spot for Mass:

→You must call the parish office each week - 857-0425, Monday or Thursday between 9 AM to 2 PM.

- \rightarrow Leave your name(s) & phone number.
- →Indicate your preference of a Saturday or Sunday Mass

→How many person(s) will attend - You will then be registered.

ightarrow You will not receive a phone call confirming that you are registered.

→Only those who we do not have room for - based on social distancing guidelines, will be notified. As you can imagine there is a great deal of work involved in taking reservations for Masses.

We ask for your continued patience as we navigate this new normal.

Elevator will not be available.

Please arrive a minimum of 15 minutes prior to Mass to allow for check in and seating.

Social distancing of 6 feet is still essential. (in and out of the church)

Entrance and exit doors - only the main doors on Botsford St. will be used. Doors will be clearly marked.

Registered attendance will be checked upon entrance.

Sanitizing - you will be given a squirt of sanitizer when you enter the church.

You will be ushered to your reserved seat.

No procession at the beginning or end of Mass.

No singing allowed by the congregation. No song books in the pews.

Holy Water Fonts - will remain empty.

Parish contributions. Donation basket will be placed at the entrance of the church.

Sign of Peace: No handshaking. Extend sign of peace with a smile, nod, etc.

<u>Communion</u>: The individual dialogue of Communion (The Body of Christ. Amen) will be done <u>collectively</u> <u>after the response "Lord I am not worthy</u>...", followed by the distribution of Communion in **SILENCE**.

<u>Communion procession</u>: The community will be directed / guided as to how to process up for communion. <u>Social distancing of 6 feet must be respected at all times</u>.

<u>At the end of Mass: do not leave the church at the same time</u> - leave the church according to a fixed order, respecting the rules of social distancing. (again you will be directed how to exit.)

The faithful are to avoid grouping or contacts among themselves or with the priest before or after services in or outside the church or in the parking lot.

Syrian Family Update

We received this update from the Settlement Office in the Diocese of Saint John.

Just a few days before Norah and Simon were to have their interviews at the immigration office in Lebanon, the offices worldwide closed, so no visas are being processed. This is disappointing for so many people waiting to come to Canada. We continue to pray for all who patiently wait while keeping safe from the virus. As soon as things open up, we will be advised. In the meantime, we continue with our financial campaign so we will be ready to receive our new family with open arms. Holding all who wait in our prayers.
