However, expenses to run our church remain constant and increase as necessary maintenance / repairs are completed. *If you are able to*, please give consideration to continuing or making up your missed donations.





- 1. <u>Packaged meals that are delivered to seniors who are experiencing food insecurity</u>. This program needs help Monday through Friday 1-4 PM (or any portion of that time) to help prepare and package meals under supervision in the Café.
- 2. Take-out dinners given out to people in need of all ages on Saturday and Sunday evenings. These meals are prepared in the Café and given out at the door of Central United Church on Queen St. by volunteers from the John Howard Society. Volunteers are needed in the Café to help prepare these meals (Saturdays and Sundays 2:30-6:30 PM). In addition to these times, help is also needed in the form of baked goods, such as cookies and sweet breads, which can be homemade or other, and can be delivered to the Café during their week day operating hours (7:45 AM 3:45 PM. Please note that you must register each week to attend Mass.

St. Bernard's Mass times are:

Friday @ 9:30 AM, Saturday @ 4 PM, & Sunday @ 11 AM

To register for Mass:

- 1. Call the parish office @ 857-0425 each week
- 2. Friday Mass-register no later than 12 noon the Thursday before
- 3. Saturday / Sunday Masses register no later than 4 PM Thursday
- 4. Inform us how many person(s) will attend, leave name(s) of attendees, and a contact phone number.
- Indicate preference of Friday, Saturday and/or Sunday Mass
 You will then be registered. You will not receive a phone call confirming that you are
 registered. Only those who we do not have room for, based on social distancing
 quidelines, will be notified.

Please arrive a minimum of 15 minutes prior to Mass to allow for sanitizing, check in process and ushered seating.

Persons 70 years of age or older, or who have medical or at-risk conditions, should carefully assess the risk when making the decision to attend Mass.

The <u>dispensation</u> (permission to be exempted from the laws or observances of the Church) of the Sunday <u>precept</u> ("You shall attend Mass on Sundays...# 2042 - Catechism of the Catholic Church) is extended for those who cannot go to church, inviting them to read the Word of God and pray in their homes and participate in the celebrations of the Mass Via the media (TV, radio, the internet).

Changes at Mass:

The elevator is available. A mask must be worn both when entering the foyer to the elevator and in the elevator. Covid guidelines/restrictions will be posted on the outer doors of the elevator. These guidelines must be followed.

Social distancing of 6 feet is still essential (inside and outside of the church)

Entrance & exit doors - only the main doors on Botsford St. will be used

Registered attendance will be checked upon entrance.

Sanitizing - you will be given a squirt of sanitizer when you enter the church

You will be ushered to your reserved seat

No procession at the beginning or end of Mass

No singing allowed by the congregation. No song books in the pews.

Holy water fonts - will remain empty.

Parish contributions - Donation basket will be placed at the entrance of the church.

Sign of peace - No handshaking. Extend sign of peace with a smile or nod.

Communion - the individual dialogue of Communion (the Body of Christ. Amen) will be done collectively after the response "Lord I Am not worthy...", followed by distribution of Communion in SILENCE.

Communion procession & exiting the church after Mass - please stay in your pews until a usher guides to process for communion or exiting the church.

Always maintain 6 feet social distancing. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.
