## From the Office of Catechetics

Dear families, children, and friends,

I am excited to start another catechetical year, with many familiar faces and some new ones.

As we navigate our new normal, gatherings may now be held without restriction as to number and social distance, although we feel it remains important to keep everyone's health and safety in mind.

Our sessions will be in-person and we will meet in the church hall. It is our belief that families will have the richest catechetical experience through gathering in person as we have done in the past. However, several families indicated that for a variety of valid reasons including concerns over COVID-19 and the scheduling conflicts, they would prefer an online format, which we will be offering as well.

Sanitizer bottles will be maintained at various locations at the entrances, allowing people to sanitize their hands if they wish.

Masks are no longer required, but respect and acceptance must be shown to those who choose to wear them for health or safety reasons.

In-person sessions will start the week of <u>Sunday September 19<sup>th</sup>,2021</u>. Registration for catechism will be on <u>Saturday, September 11<sup>th</sup> from 12 noon-1:30 PM, in the main hall.</u> Returning families, please keep an eye on your Inbox as I will be sending out registration forms via email.

The Registration Fee is \$30.00 for one child family and \$50.00 for families with more than one child. These fees are set by the Diocese to help offset the cost of the program and can be paid at the office or at our in-person registration. Unfortunately, we are not set up for e-transfers at this time.

<u>Please note</u>: all families planning to register with St. Bernard's catechism program <u>must</u> be registered as a family with St. Bernard's Church. Please complete the form if:

- You and your family are new to our parish.
- > If your family information has changed.
- If you are unsure if your family is registered, then please complete a form.

For our parishes and communities, that they may be places of welcome and compassion, where all are recognized as beloved children of God.



Effective September 1, the former Offices of Faith Development and Youth Faith Development will be referred to as the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis.
